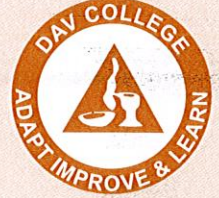

### 1. Term 4

Term 4 ends on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2022, Term 1 2022 will start

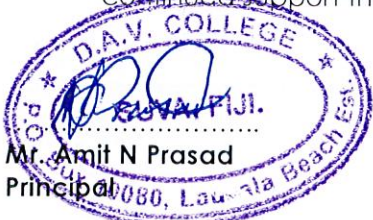
