1. Term 1 Examination

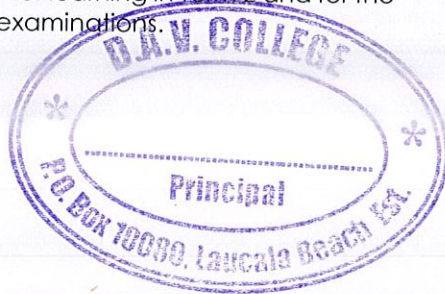
